A post-doctoral position is available to study the developmental mechanisms of new stem cell formation in Arabidopsis root using molecular, genetic, genomic and microscopy approaches. The post-doc will perform research to identify the molecular mechanisms involved in cell polarity/polarization. Applicants are expected to a PhD in developmental molecular biology and genuine interest in science. Previous research experience in confocal imaging will be considered.
