## Job Opening at Madrid (Spain) Senior Scientist

The CBGP is seeking for a highly motivated and productive **Senior Scientist** to join a recognized research group and boost **nitrogen fixation research** in one of the following research areas:

- Nitrogenase oxidative protection
- Mitochondria and/or chloroplast biotechnology
- Synthetic Biology

**The expectation is that the candidate will develop synergistic research with the host group and will be successful in grant applications for national and international project calls.** The main criteria for selection will be scientific excellence, experience in the above areas, a track record of research impact and future projection.

### **CBGP offers:**

The CBGP offers 4 years of contract at Distinguished Scientist level. CBGP offers competitive negotiable salary that will depend on qualifications of the selected candidate. This position is regulated by Spanish legislation and regulations under a full-time contract, having all the benefits of the Spanish Social Security system covering sickness, maternity/paternity leaves and injuries at work.

The candidate will join a fully equipped laboratory with funds to cover research and the salaries of PhD students, technicians and postdoctoral researchers (4-year term).

### **Position requirements, application procedure and deadline**

Senior Scientist candidates should have less than 12 years of postdoctoral experience. Applications must include a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statement of research, and two recommendation letters with contact details.
