The Manager will also be responsible of the identification of potential partners, in the areas of Sustainable and Digitalized Agriculture (National and international) to collaborate with and to incorporate to the community. The Manager will be responsible of the organization of events (Workshop Conferences) and activities of the community, and of the outreach/communication activities.

Profile: Bachelor/Degree in Agriculture Engineering, Biological Sciences or similar formation, and preferentially with Master specialization in similar fields. The candidate must have experience in the management and preparation of International projects applications and identification of opportunities (FP7, H2020, Horizon Europe, etc.) and in the organization of international events (Workshop, Conferences, etc.). The candidate should have experience in the management of national calls (Spanish Research Agency, CDTI, etc.). A high level of English is required. Additional required skills are: communication and outreach capacities, well organization, capacities to prepare presentation for the members of the community, data analysis, management of social networks and web pages. Candidate must have at least 5 years of experience in this area.

Contract Conditions: Full time job with a gross salary of up to 31 k€ and contract for one year and a maximum of 3 years duration.
